Coleman played at Washington and Lee University from 2000-2003. She played in 76 career games for the Generals with a record of 55-14-7. During this time, the team set new school records for wins in a season (17), goals scored in a season (74), and had the longest unbeaten streak of 20 games. Heather won two ODAC conference championship titles and made two NCAA tournament appearances in 2002 and 2003, scoring the winning goal in the NCAA 1st round in 2002 versus Greensboro College. Coleman was named All-Conference honorable mention in 2001, CoSIDA All-District first team and an Academic All-American in 2003. She finished with 19 goals and 7 assists in her career with a cumulative GPA of 4.07. Heather also played basketball from 2000-2002.

Most Memorable Moment The ODAC Championship game versus Lynchburg which Coleman describes as a “delirium-producing marathon.” Off the soccer field my most memorable moment was deciding to drive to Charlottesville with Meghan and Fontaine senior year with the sole purpose of testing out the warm-up tape.
